Horsenettle

Type: Perennial

- A troublesome weed mostly found in pastures and orchards. Has a deep taproot with rhizomes, but doesn't have any stolons.

Leaf: Broadleaf

- Thick alternating leaves with lobed edges. Leaves have yellowish prickles (spines) located underneath along the midrib.

Control

- Horsenettle is mostly controlled/suppressed through clipping, however a fall herbicide treatment is recommended to kill the small shoots and reduce population. For more information on specific products and rates please contact Fred Kungl or Charlie Kail.
